

- The Council of Commissioners approved that Commissioner Marilyne Boyer represent the Lester B. Pearson School Board at the Canadian Association for the Practical Study of Law in Education conference to be held in Toronto from April 28-30, 2024 and that expenses be reimbursed in accordance with the School Board's Policy governing Commissioners' Local Travel, Conference and Other Expenses.
- The Council of Commissioners approved the professional service contracts be awarded, in accordance with the tender documents and as per the Act Respecting Contracting by Public Bodies and the Regulation Respecting the Service Contracts of Public Bodies, to:

- The Council of Commissioners approved that approval be given to the Lester B. Pearson School Board's

 before taxes.
